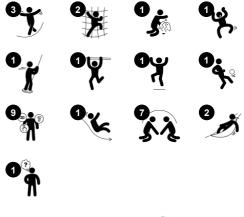

The Two Towers with Wobbly Bridge offers playful social-emotional as well as physical growth for toddlers. The seating under the climbing tower with fireman's pole makes this a fun unit in its own right. The fireman's pole and inclined net entry point is for more experienced climbers, training risk-taking and proprioception. For children who want to play it safer, the slide section allows for high-paced, cardio and balance packed looping, sliding down then climbing back up the steps. The wobble bridge invites thrilling balance training with friends, encouraging cooperation and consideration. It also trains the senses of balance and space, important for managing the world securely. The fun play panels and desk encourage logical thinking skills and invite dramatic play supporting the development of children's language skills.

Balcony Social-Emotional: the balcony invites meetings and interaction with people on ground level. Cognitive: invites dramatic play and performance, which stimulates language development.





Slide

Physical: sliding develops spatial awareness and a sense of balance. Furthermore, the core muscles are trained when sitting upright going down. Social-Emotional: empathy stimulated by turn-taking. Cognitive: young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when sliding down quickly.



Fireman's pole

Physical: coordination is supported when going down, as well as arm and core muscles. Landing strengthens bone density, which is built for life in early childhood. Social-Emotional: turn-taking and risk-taking. Cognitive: young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when gliding down fast.



Climbing net

Physical: supports physical strength and cross-body coordination, which impacts coordination of the right and left part of brain, fundamental for other skills such as the ability to read.



Desk

Social-Emotional: fine meeting place and a space creator. Sharing and cooperation from both sides create a social scenario that supports communication and cooperation.



Wackle bridge

Physical: sense of balance and space, and training of posture. Important for being able to sit still. **Social-Emotional:** cooperation, turn-taking and friendly competition on the plates.

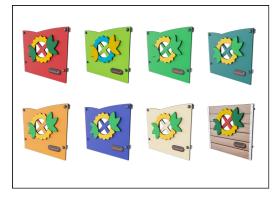


Abacus Cognitive: supports understanding of measures.

Main posts with hot dip galvanized steel footing are available in different materials: Pressure impregnated pine wood posts. Pre-galvanized inside and outside with powder coated top finish steel posts. Lead free aluminum with color anodized top finish. Greenline TexMade posts of 95% post-consumer recycled PE and textile waste.



All decks are supported by unique designed low-carbon aluminum profiles with multiple attachment options. The grey colored molded decks are made of 75% post-consumer waste PP material with a non-skid pattern and texture surface.

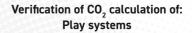

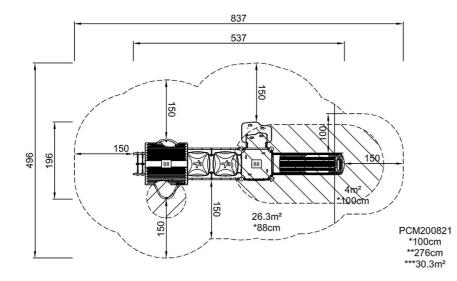


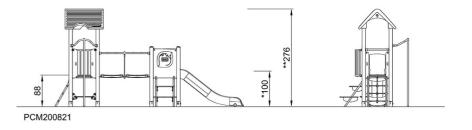
